Kidney disease is often referred to as a "silent epidemic," as there are typically no symptoms until the kidneys fail and dialysis is necessary to sustain life.

Kidney disease can be diagnosed by a simple blood test. If kidney disease is discovered in its earlier stages, underlying conditions causing kidney failure can be treated to potentially slow or stop the progression of the disease.
